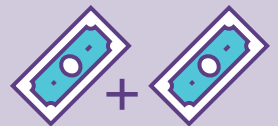

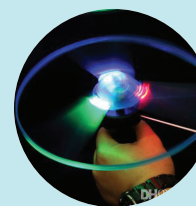

In 2019, Cedar Wood students and parents had an amazing Whale Walk! Our ONE & ONLY all-school fundraiser brought in over \$40,000!

The majority of this supports our general PTA budget, which funds classroom teachers and PTA sponsored programs throughout the year.

In 2019, we funded additional grants so that every teacher & staff member was able to use funds to buy supplies for their Classrooms and special programs for virtual education. We bought additional library books and headphones for students. We provided grant funding to sponsor the Raz Kids online program, and funded the Art Docent program, the robotics club, and safety patrol. We provided rewards for iReady participation, and funded the 5th grade celebration. We also contributed to the regional PTA shoe fund and the Mill Creek food bank.

If we go beyond our goal of \$38,000, just think of what we could do for Cedar Wood this year. Every dollar counts!
